2003 Cohn Vineyard Russian River Valley Pinot Noir

This is our 4th vintage from Cohn Vineyard. Reaching almost 40 years in age, Cohn Vineyard produces Pinot Noir with extraordinary depth and complexity. This wine is showing classic Russian river varietal along with deep structure, rich mouth-feel and a wide array of aromatics and flavors.

Aromatics: Rich raspberry and cherry laced with creamy vanilla, white pepper, cola and a touch of wild mushroom.

On the Palate: Juicy raspberries, cherry and sweet spice with an elegant, deep structure. The mid-palate runs deep with plum and ripe, black cherry finishing with lingering vanilla, cola and wild strawberries. Elegant yet deep, this wine will evolve in the glass. Enjoy every moment.
