

Eight miles from the Pacific Ocean, at an elevation just above the coastal fog, our 14-acre Treehouse Vineyard is set in the heartland of the Russian River Valley. Previously, this land was used for grazing cattle, which meant there was no need for a source of water. To this day, water must be carted up to the vineyard to hydrate the vines which were first planted in 2006. Bounded by cypress trees and majestic redwoods, this site is a natural masterpiece shaped by sun-kissed days and unique iron-rich soils that create a Pinot Noir with profound depth and complexity.

Treehouse Vineyard produced an extremely concentrated Pinot Noir in 2019. From start to finish, picking took one month to complete. Alluring aromas of ripe raspberry, pomegranate, and dark cherry highlight the impressive structure with a youthful core and integrated tannins. A vibrant and round texture finishes with subtle notes of savory herbs and cinnamon.

Fact of Note: One individual lot went completely through carbonic fermentation.
