

Established in 1997, Garys' Vineyard is a partnership between the acclaimed Franscioni and Pisoni winegrowing families. Though located just a few miles south of Rosella's Vineyard, Garys' yields a unique expression of Pinot Noir. This powerful wine, akin to the two pioneering Garys who founded it, exudes a larger-than-life presence.

Crafted from the tightly-clustered and thick-skinned Pisoni clone, Garys' Vineyard inherently possesses a broad opulence. Decadent flavors of black cherry, ripe strawberry, and blackberry are complemented by elusive hints of savory dried herbs. This wine's profound harmony and refinement leave a lasting impression, captivating the senses through an enduring finish.

Fact of Note: There were four different harvest picks spread across twelve days.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE Dark and brooding aromatics of black cherry, and ripe strawberry, with understated notes of dried herbs.

MOUTH Unprecedented finesse illuminates a generous core of ripe raspberry and dark fruit that unfurls to a long, gratifying finish.
